



Master Plan

Guy Sturt was project manager and Landscape Architect with LDI international for two years on the Denarau Island project, Fiji. His role ranged from preparation of the brief through design, documentation and construction administration.

The project involved \$14 million of landscape works including the construction of a 27 hole golf course and clubhouse, condominium housing, a marina and three hotels. The project incorporated the existing Regent of Fiji and Sheraton Hotels situated on site.

The first stage included construction of infrastructure, the golf course and a five star hotel.

The hotel was created around a one hectare artificial lagoon and included sand beaches, islands, a cascade and river pools in addition to pool bars and foreshore facilities.

Work was completed in an environment not geared for major construction projects. As a result the role of project manager required a number of services outside the normal scope of practice. This included the tagging and transplanting of over 1500 mature palms and the establishment of a temporary holding nursery. Plant procurement contracts were established and a site nursery designed and constructed.
