



Blue Hills Wetland

Glenmore Park is one of the largest residential sites in Western Sydney. It is a fully integrated master planned estate which is home to over 20,000 people.

Sturt Noble Associates were engaged to master plan and design all landscape elements for new release areas. The Master Plan provides for large areas of open space to be linked to form a system of parklands with connections to the newly created Blue Hills Wetland. The project is unique in that the whole range of best practice environmental design techniques have been integrated in a private sector development. This has included environmental planning, wetland design, riparian rehabilitation and creekline reconstruction, bio-engineering, bush regeneration and protection of threatened Cumberland Plain woodland areas.

Sturt Noble Associates were engaged to master plan and design all landscape elements for new release areas. This included a new display village for the new Lakeside release situated alongside the new wetland. Our team developed the entire entry experience including carpark layouts, pedestrian links, sales office gardens and a children's playground.

Planning has included design of street tree planting, small parks and entry statements. Sturt Noble Associates were also engaged to implement and project manage public education, public art, interpretation and public facilities.
