



Curvilinear off form walls provide seating edge for lunch time traffic

Sturt Noble Associates was engaged by FKP to design the central open space plaza in this refurbished commercial development within the Chatswood CBD

Already highly regarded, this building has been transformed into a stylish new office and retail centre by awarded architects Krikis Taylor. The development has been redesigned to achieve a 5-Star NABERS rating and registered for a 4 Star Green Star.

The central plaza forms the heart of the commercial development and a series of raised planters and lawns provides a focus for tenants to view from their offices above and for visitors to the ground level retail.

The curvilinear off form concrete planter walls create a strong design element and also provide an extensive seating edge for lunch time traffic. Large massed plantings create a highly textured plant palette to provide interest year round and include species such as Giant Bromeliads, Agaves and Flax.
