Anson Property Group engaged Sturt Noble Associates to prepare a Master Plan for the Development Application of Burwood Square Commercial/ Residential Development and public realm works.

The Public domain design is laid in a striking set out to generate interest and assist wayfinding. Off form concrete planters with coloured glazed brick inlay are designed to provide multiple seating opportunities to plaza and future development and mounded to accommodate larger shade trees.

All private domain works are located on a basement podium requiring careful consideration of soil depths and level changes. A communal BBQ area is located at the northern end of communal including sustainably sourced timber shelter structure, picnic tables and timber topped platform seating.

Larger feature trees chosen for their seasonal show, canopy shelter and amenity are located in minimum 900mm depth of soil incorporated into 1: 20 accessible slope. In select locations lawn areas roll up to deeper soil for planting negating the need for additional concrete walls in all areas.

Multiple small group and individual opportunity spaces are located across the sites and timber topped off form concrete benches form larger group social areas. Areas to immediate north of the Temple are open to the general public and a potential café space is located here.
